2024 WORLD YOUTH DEVELOPMENT FORUM TOGETHER FOR A BETTER FUTURE

The World Youth Development Forum (WYDF) is an important platform where young people worldwide can contribute to global development and global efforts are gathered to promote youth development. Responding to President Xi Jinping's proposal at the High–level Dialogue on Global Development in 2022, the WYDF is an important measure to pool youth strength to implement the United Nations 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and Global Development Initiative (GDI).

The first World Youth Development Forum was held in Beijing in 2022, with President Xi Jinping sending a congratulatory message to the Forum. The second World Youth Development Forum was convened in Beijing and Shenzhen in 2023. The two sessions of the forum have achieved positive results by advancing international youth agenda, advocating for international youth actions and promoting global development and youth development.

The 2024 WYDF, with the theme of "Together for a Better Future", opened in Beijing on August 12 at the International Youth Day. More than 2,000 young people from over 130 countries and 20 international organizations participated both online and on-site.

Youth Lightning Talks

Youth delegates delivered Youth Lightning Talks on the theme "Together for a Better Future", focusing on exploring solutions to climate change, agricultural development, education, artificial intelligence and health that affect future generations and global development, and putting forward visions and action initiatives in conjunction with the Summit of the Future in September 2024.



Outcomes

1. The forum launched the International Youth Advocacy for the Summit of the Future, which urged countries to establish effective mechanisms for the implementation of youth development policies and to guarantee the right of young people to development; and expressed young people's pledge to be open-minded, innovative, embrace cooperation, take up common responsibilities and unite in the struggle to accelerate the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and the GDI.

What other activities held in the framework of the forum?

On August 13, the Youth Pre–Meeting for the Summit of the Future was held in Beijing. Over 300 participants, including ministers of youth affairs, youth leaders and youth representatives from nearly 100 countries held group discussions on five topics: Sustainable Development and Financing for Development; International Peace and Security; Scientific and Technological Innovation and Digital Cooperation; Youth and Future Generations; and Transformation of Global Governance. The report was submitted by the All–China Youth Federation to the organizers of the Summit of the Future through diplomatic channels.
